SANA Accomplishments:

Since our last Annual Meeting on April 27, 2023, the Singing Arrow Neighborhood Association (SANA) has:

- Reinstated SANA's registration in good standing with the New Mexico Secretary of State
- Officially approved the logo for SANA
- Conducted 10 Board of Directors meetings held on:
May 4, 2023; May 11, 2023; June 8, 2023; July 13, 2023; August 10, 2023; September 14, 2023; October 12, 2023; January 11, 2024; February 8, 2024; and March 14, 2024.
- Conducted 3 Neighborhood events/meetings:
National Night Out on August 1, 2023
Holiday Cookie Exchange on November 30, 2023
Neighborhood Meeting on February 29, 2024
- Participated in the 1st Annual Multicultural Arts Festival at the Singing Arrow Community Center on May 6, 2023
- Attended meetings concerning ABQ's Housing Forward initiative and a Starbuck's to be constructed within the Smith's parking lot, and submitted comments to Councilor Grout's office
- When possible, individual Directors attended relevant meetings of the ABQ City Council, Office of Neighborhood Coordination, East Gateway Coalition and Community Policing Council

- Attended an informational meeting and subsequently supported plans of Consensus Planning, ABQ Parks and Recreation Department - Open Space Division, the Tijeras Cultural Corridor Committee and other partners, to not only preserve but also improve elements of the Tijeras Creek Cultural Corridor, the Tijeras Arroyo Biological Zone and other contiguous areas
- Collaborated with the Office of Neighborhood Coordination, ABQ Youth and Family Services and Councilor Grout's office to procure signage to be used to announce SANA meetings and events; will be installed at the Singing Arrow Community Center
- Developed a website: www.singingarrow.org
- Previous to the 2024 Annual Meeting, we reviewed the Bylaws and determined that no revisions were indicated at this time
- As of the date of this Annual Meeting, we have 32 active SANA members for 2024 and 89 non-active members who have not renewed

Treasury contains \$2,425.52 as of April 4, 2024 (contained \$2,738.08 as of 2023 Annual Meeting)

As with all ABQ neighborhood associations, SANA is prohibited from charging annual membership dues, so its activities are limited. Incidental costs for meetings, printing, refreshments, etc. were largely personally borne by SANA officers and directors.
