Community Issues Impacting SANA:

- Crime and Security – A Bernalillo County Sherriff’s Office has been activated in Four Hills Village
- Upcoming Council Vote on Housing Forward 0-22-54 which would allow:
 - Two-family dwellings permissively in the R-1 Zone District, Citywide

- Allow detached Accessory Dwelling Units with kitchens permissively in the R-1 Zone District, Citywide
- Exempt all conversions from non-residential development to multi-family dwellings from the definition of a kitchen.
- Eliminate Building height maximums for multi-family residential development and mixed-use development
- Exempt affordable housing from off-street parking requirements
- Add a parking reduction for multi-family dwellings in mixed-use zone districts
- Safe Open Spaces (SOS) resolution which would allow the designation of SOS without a public hearing
- East Central Park & Ride – 100 space park & ride facility to be constructed in 2024. Site location pending.
- Zone Change request for Fire Station in Franklin Plaza, opportunity for neighborhood meeting.
